Until 2018, Herman Webb, Loretta Lynn's brother, ran the store and offered tours of their childhood home down the road. Herman Webb passed away in 2018, leaving the General Store as a reminder of the area's rich history. The store was portrayed in the movies "Coal Miner's Daughter", "Let It Be War", and "Fifth Hollar". We will then make our way to Lexington, KY where dinner will be included and we will check in to our hotel for the night. (D)
