Day 1, Tuesday, October 14, 2025

Here you will be greeted by a member of their team to answer questions before exploring the museum at your leisure. Lunch will be on your own in their café. Included in your experience at Corning Museum of Glass will be creating your own sandblasted glass that you will take home with you! After a fun filled day at the museum, you will depart this afternoon to check into your hotel for the evening, the historic Penn Wells in beautiful Wellsboro. Freshen up before dinner included at the hotel this evening.
