Saturday, June 13, 2026

7AM Depart for Michigan. Check into your Lansing Michigan area hotel. Dinner is included this evening. Enjoy the evening to rest and relax. (D)

Sunday, June 14, 2026

Depart for Mackinaw City with a Fast Food stop “on own” Grab the Ferry to the Island for your 2 night stay at the Grand Hotel America’s Original Grand Hotel a place of old world hospitality and charm. Upon Arrival enjoy a carriage tour of the Island. You will be on the Island for the Lilac Festival. The Annual Mackinac Island Lilac Festival is the largest and most historic festival on Mackinac Island. It began in June 1949 by two local residents. Celebrating the lilacs and their uniqueness and history to Mackinac Island. You will be able to enjoy live music, the Grand Parade, and more! Upon arrival on the island we will have a carriage tour then you will have the choice to be dropped off down town for the parade and activities or if you prefer you can be dropped off at the hotel to relax. Our first stop will be for a ride on the Bavarian Belle Riverboat! Take in the views, and receive a narrated tour of Frankenmuth on the Cass River. Afterwards, we’ll have lunch at a local restaurant, followed by free time at the River Place Shops. Tonight we will check into the Bavarian Inn Lodge for your 2 night stay. Since its original founding as the Union House in 1888, the Bavarian Inn has been offering an extraordinary blend of great German food and hospitality in Frankenmuth. As the years have passed, they’ve added the Lodge and Conference Center and over 20 retail locations to the family holdings, but the traditions of quality, service and fun; begun over 100 years ago still hold true. Enjoy a German Dinner tonight at the Bavarian Inn Lodge with Live Music! Dinner tonight is a German favorite-Jaeger Schnitzel: A meaty center-cut pork loin chop topped with our own Bavarian mushroom sauce, served with potato cheese dumplings, hot vegetable, breadsticks, tossed salad, chef’s choice dessert, and coffee, tea, milk, or soda, dinner & live entertainment at the lodge. Wednesday, June 17

Enjoy Oma's Breakfast Buffet this morning including: Scrambled Eggs, Pancakes, Sausage, Tater Tots, Seasonal Fresh Fruit, Apfel Streusel, Sausage Gravy, Biscuits, Coffee Cake, Cold Cereals, and Coffee, Tea, or Milk. With full bellies, we'll now take a bus tour where a step-on guide will join our coach and give a tour of Frankenmuth and the history behind the town. Afterwards, we will explore the Frankenmuth Historical Museum—take in the 11 gallery museum, learning the history of Frankenmuth from 1845 to present. Next, we'll make our way to the world's largest Christmas store, Bronner's Christmas Wonderland! From humble beginnings in 1945, Bronner's Christmas Wonderland has grown to become the World's Largest Christmas store. Feel free to grab a bite to eat "on your own" at their Season's Eating's Cafe. Visit the Castle Shops for all the great souvenirs, baked goods and treats you want to take home before going back to the hotel to relax and freshen up for dinner. Our evening will begin with a wine tasting, sampling several private label German wines, followed by a glockenspiel viewing. The Bavarian Inn Glockenspiel Tower houses a magnificent 35-bell carillon, a beautiful figurine movement and an illuminated clock, all imported from Germany! Before striking the hour, and on each quarter hour, the clock sounds the 5-bell Westminster chime. The Glockenspiel plays several selections which are immediately followed by figurine movement depicting the legend of the Pied Piper of Hameln. Then get ready for the World Famous Frankenmuth Chicken® Dinner served with fluffy mashed potatoes, Frankenmuth dressing, vegetables, and piping hot gravy! (B, D)
